## JESSE JACKSON CALL FOR ASIAN SUPPORT AND VOTE

On February 7, 1988, 3 pm in the afternoon, Asians for Jesse Jackson held a press conference in Chinatown calling for more Asian support for the Jesse Jackson campaign and recommending support for May Chen of the ILGWU-Local 23-25 bid for Delegate to the National Democratic Convention.

In the New York area the presidential primary will be held on April 19th where delegates to the conventions will be decided in both parties. The delegates for New York State will attend the National Convention and will cast their vote to those Presidential candidates who won in the primary.

There were over 50 people attending the February 7 press conference and Cindy Ng of the Manhattan Borough President's Office Special assistant also showed up at this meeting.

Asians for Jesse Jackson encouraged Chinese people to register and cast their vote on the April 19th primary day. The deadline for registering is February 19th.

 傑亞·傑克遜亞裔助選委員會昨(七)日鄭重宣佈全力支持傑亞·傑克遜競選總統。

該助選委員會代表陳兆文律師與丁勤時區長助理伍新蘭，昨日下午三時在華埠亞美藝術中心舉行記者會上作上項宣佈。陳、伍兩人指出傑克遜積極倡導非歧視性合乎人道的移民政策，雙語教育並要求政府各階層增加亞裔及其他少數民族的代表性。傑克遜並對日裔就第二次世界大戰被監禁、要求賠償的支持到對待韓國、菲律賓等亞洲國家的人權問題所採取的立場和在陳果仁事件中均表示關懷和支持。傑克遜並主張聯邦政府增撥住屋、青年、耆老等公共服務和社會福利。

### ASIANS FOR JESSE JACKSON SUPPORT JACKSON'S BID FOR THE PRESIDENCY

Asians for Jesse Jackson announced that they are going to give full support to Jesse Jackson in his bid for the Presidency. The committee representative Rocky Chin, attorney and Manhattan Borough President special assistant Cindy Ng made the above announcement in the press conference held on Sunday February 7th, 3 pm at Asian American Arts Centre. Chin and Ng both point out that Jesse Jackson is a strong advocate for a non-discriminatory humane immigration policy, and bilingual education and demand the increase of representation of Asian and minority in all levels of government. Jesse Jackson also supports the Japanese Americans demand for Redress/Reparations and also takes a clear stand on human rights issues in Korea, Philippines, and Asian countries. In the Vincent Chin case, he also showed concern and support. Jesse Jackson also demands the increase of federal funding to all types of social programs.
