INVITATION TO THE 26TH WORLD CONFERENCE AGAINST A AND H BOMBS

Dear Friends,

I, on behalf of the Japan Congress against Atomic and Hydrogen Bombs (GENSUIKIN), have a great pleasure to extend a cordial invitation to you for attending the 26th Anniversary World Conference against A and H Bombs to be held in Tokyo, Hiroshima and Nagasaki. The schedule of the World Conference is as follows:

August 2, 3 and 4 in Tokyo

International Conference

August 5, 6 and 7 in Hiroshima

Hiroshima Conference with participants
of 10,000
Classified Meeting
Specialist Meetings on particular
subjects such as Nike J missiles

August 8 and 9 in Nagasaki

Nagasaki Conference with participants
of 10,000
Meeting with atomic sufferers
Specialist Meetings on atomic power
generation problems and etc.

The aim of the World Conference is to mobilise international movements for "No more Hiroshima" on earth and for the general and complete prohibition of nuclear weapons. In the Conference of this year, discussion will be focused upon urgent problems in face of us: (1) Immediate cessation of the US aggressive war in Indochina in which tactical nuclear weapons may be used by the US forces (2) Stop of nuclear arm race, particularly signing of international pacts on non-use of nuclear weapons and on ban of underground test, (3) Establishment of Peace and Security System in Asia and other part of the world in place of military

pacts, (4) Unconditional return of Okinawa islands to Japan and opposition to the revival of militarism of Japan, (5) Promotion of international solidarity and joint action against war and nuclear weapons, and so on. You will have soon the keynote report and main themes of the International Conference after adopted in the preparatory committee.

In order to ensure the success of the World Conference, I would like to stress the necessity of your participation in the Conference. Your representation will be of great contribution to advancing movements in Japan and abroad, and to achieving international solidarity against A and H bombs.

We are looking forward to meeting you in Tokyo, coming August.
