DO YOU KNOW that under the provisions of the McCarran Internal Security Act of 1950, at least 8 concentration camps have already been set up in Pennsylvania, Florida, Oklahoma and Arizona – and YOU may be the next victim?

DO YOU KNOW that the Eastland "Internal Security Act of 1968" is a blueprint for a police state - and that it CAN HAPPEN HERE?

HOW WAS IT POSSIBLE that during a war against Nazism (World War II) a whole group of people from three states were, almost overnight, thrown into these camps?
