



Wartime 442 Head Dies in Ft. Benning

Brigadier General Charles W.
Pence, (U.S. Army, Ret.), warime commander of the 442nd Regimental Combat team, died Oct.

At the time of his death General Pence was an executive officer of the National Bank of Fort

Under his command the Japanesee American unit, through its feats became the most decorated unit of its size in the history of the U.S. Armed Forces. Then a colonel, General Pence was decorated with the Distinguished Service Medal, the Croix de Guerre from France, and Purple Heart.


He was injured in action during the Vosges campaign in Eastern France, a battle which was climaxed by the relief of a battalion of the 36th Division to which the In 25 days






