### "HUMANITARIANISM" YESTERDAY...

In 1885, the Belgian King Leopold seized the territory of the Congo, and publicly proclaimed, "We are launching one of the greatest civilizing and humanitarian crusades of history; to destroy the slave-trade in the Congo." But to a friend, he wrote, "What a splendid slice of cake!"

### ... AND TODAY

Now it is the U.S. that has entered the Congo on the pretext of "humanitarianism". But it is as phony now as it was in 1885. The U.S. began pouring arms, money, paratroopers and CIA agents into the Congo long before any hostages were taken by the so-called rebel forces. (The term "rebel" is a slander against the Gbenye government, whose leaders are the only figures in the Congo who were democratically elected after independence.)

Beginning last summer, U.S. planes bombed, strafed and burnt to the ground scores of villages. The restraint of the "rebels" toward the European civilians was extraordinary. As recently as October 23, the N.Y. Times interviewed a white Portuguese merchant who praised the rebel army for its discipline and honesty.

### WAY BACK LAST AUGUST

"Off to Leopoldville last week winged four C-130 Hercules transports... Aboard the big planes were 44 hand-picked U.S. paratroopers---equipped with Jeeps, bazookas, grenade launchers and machine guns... The U.S. has given Tshombe's army about ten C-47 transport planes, ten helicopters, 70 Jeeps, 250 trucks, and seven of the ubiquitous little T-28 trainers that have proved so useful on strafing and bombing missions against Communist guerrillas in Southeast Asia. Washington was even thoughtful enough to provide the pilots-and sensitive enough to American public opinion to have recruited them from the ranks of anti-Castro Cubans."

### RACIST MERCENARIES MUST GO!

The Organization of African Unity, representing the great majority of the African continent, last week condemned the action of the U.S. and Belgium as "international banditry masquerading under the lofty banner of humanitarianism," and assailed Tshombe as a "brigand," an "imperialist stooge," a "Western puppet," and a "pirate."
