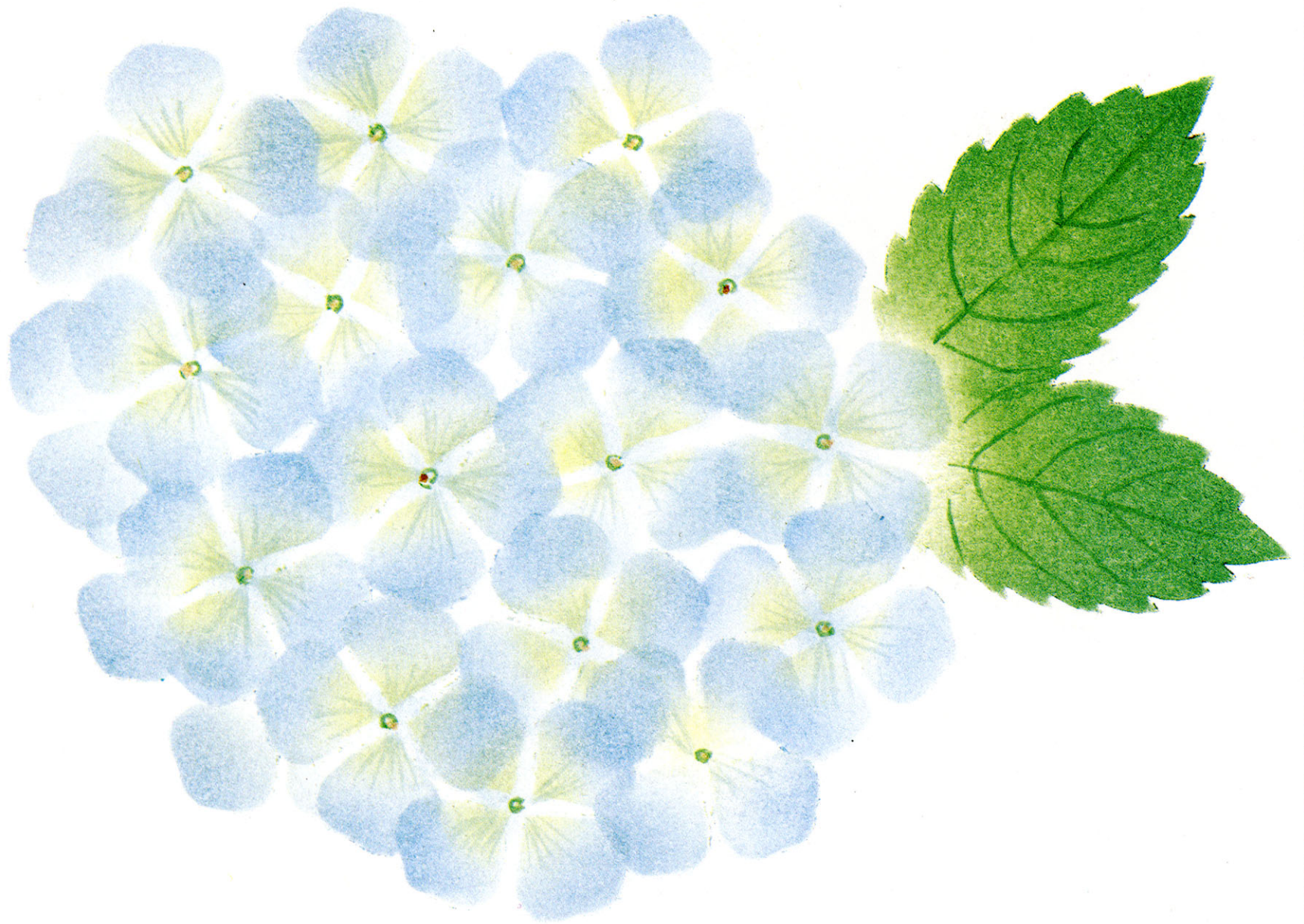


Yuri
