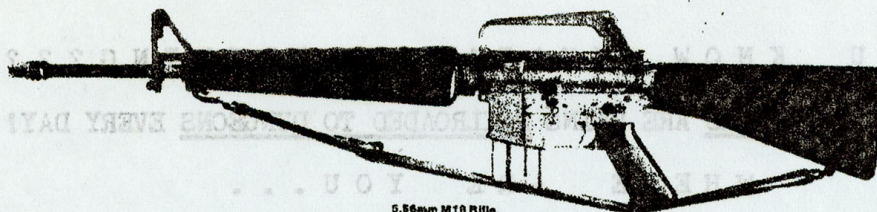

FREE VICTOR CUMBERBATCH

Who is Victor Cumberbatch?

Victor Cumberbatch is a brother who like many black youth, grew up in one of the oppressive ghetto's of New York (Brooklyn).

He attended the schools of mis-education designed for black, poor, and oppressed people, finishing high school in Brooklyn. Brother Victor joined the B.P.P. in 1969, and immediately showed his worth by organizing and advancing the free breakfast programs in Brooklyn; eventually making coordinator of the New York chapter. This brother also worked on the free clothing drive, soliciting donations from the avaricious businessmen, ripping off the people of Brownsville to help provide clothing for our youth in school.

During the same time, Richard "Watergate" Nixon saw fit to cut the welfare checks of the poor so that he could help support Lockheed and other military industries making war material for the butchering and extermination of the peoples of Southeast Asia.

Due to the split in the B.P.P. when Huey Newton went over to the U.S. govt., Brother Victor chose to continue to work and serve his people as opposed to serving the "Newton Clique interest." As a result of his uncompromising stand to maintain his revolutionary vigilance and not waver his principles, rumors were falsely spread (by police and provocateur agents) about Victor and other comrades, accusing them of "subversive acts" against the govt., forcing the brother to split (go underground).

Like so many others of his comrades, he was hunted (nationally) for acts he supposedly committed without a thread of evidence. Brother Victor, along with another un-identified man apparently emerged in the Bronx enroute to some unknown destination, was vamped on by one of New York's foulest who recognized him (probably from posters which have been circulated in several states) and attempted to capture/kill him. Rather than become another fatality statistics, he chose to defend himself, leaving one less mercenary to plunder and terrorize our black community.

It is alleged by the N.Y. P.D. that Brother Victor is a member of a revolutionary organization known as the (B.L.A.) who is said to be responsible for "retalitory and defensive" actions taken against the N.Y.P.D. and other repressive and oppressive agencies of the govt local and national. Whether or not he is member of the B.L.A. is not known. What is known is that Brother Victor is a revolutionary and a servant of Black and oppressed people who **MUST BE SET FREE!** This brother's life is hanging in the twilight. He must be assured by our people he is not alone. **FREE VICTOR CUMBERBATCH** and all P.O.W.S and **POLITICAL PRISONERS** of U.S.A. **FASCISM NOW!**
