Discussion and Concensus

We agreed to jointly work on a program for the Day of Rememberance which would both target the Asian American Community as well as outreach to a broader audience. We wanted to have the program at the Riverside Church or the Buddhist Church. (We since learned that the Riverside Church was not available, and we will have the program at the Buddhist Church.) And we settled on a program time for Saturday afternoon, February 23, 1985 in the early afternoon to accommodate those issei who prefer not to be out after dark.

Leslee reported that there are monies left over from the E.C.J.A.R. efforts of a couple of years ago, which all of the Japanese American organizations and community worked towards collecting; and proposed that it would be appropriate to use the funds for this upcoming program. All agreed.

We agreed to use Steven Okazaki's film, "Unfinished Business," in the program with half of the net proceeds to go to Steven.

The groups in the coalition agreed to:

- (1) endorse the Day of Remberance event
- (2) endorse all forms of redress
- (3) help publicize the event with members
- (4) at this time, it is not necessary to have dues or payment to the coalition from groups
- (5) consider working on ongoing work, to possibly include training workshos (to train more redress speakers;) to do more organized education programs at non-Asian American groups, etc.
