COMMITTEE REPORTS

- 1) Treasurer's report

MONSERRAT APPT.

- 1) one rep. from AAPA, one rep. from AAA were asked to attend meeting with Monserrat on Thursday at 4:00 PM
 - a) Tak and Terry chosen as reps.

- 2) what questions to pose??
 - a) issue of redistricting
 1. Chinese community might be split up or engulfed in larger district, thus resulting in loss of community control
 - b) problem centering around Unit Administrator
 1. do we support Fuentes??
 2. or if not, who do we support??
 - c) problem of apathy on part of Chinese (esp. parents) in the community re community control
 1. Chinese have favored side of the govt. rather than Puerto Ricans and blacks, thus resulting in hostilities between the racial groups involved
- 3) suggestions
 - a) write pamphlet explaining issue of redistricting and community control, then distributing it to h.s. kids and their parents
 - b) get support of the teachers in the schools involved
 - c) but first, invite Harold Lui and Shin'ya Ono to come and speak concerning the issue

WASH. D.C. NOV. DEMONSTRATION

- 1) question of whether to endorse and participate in the New Mobe demonstration
- 2) it was announced that the Third World People in Solidarity With the Vietnamese will demonstrate with New Mobe but as a separate contingent
 - a) we were asked to join their contingent
 - b) Chris to investigate
