Dear Lam:

We received your notice about the actions in April. We discussed our participation in the program and decided to concentrate our activities in getting as many people down for the demonstration on Sunday, April 12th. Toward that end, we have printed leaflets (enclosed) that we are sending out to all the people on our mailing list as well as giving it out to places that we are asked to speak, particularly high school Asian Clubs and college groups.

We have a number of questions however. In discussing the New York Times ad, we thought that the money might be better used in other areas. There are a great number of people in jails and potentially going to jail that will be needing money for defense as well as peace and militant organizations that are in great financial trouble and we feel that our money should be going to them rather than to the Times. Second, we wondered if a workshop on the U.S.-Japan Security Treaty and its relation to the war and U.S. Imperialism might be included in the conference program.

Anyway, please send us more information so that we can give more information to those who contact our group. If you need help on publicity, police permits, etc., please let us know. See you in Washington!
