We are all going to Wash. D. C. and will participate in the Sat. and Sun. activities. Though information is incomplete as yet, there is supposed to be a "Contingent in Solidarity with the Vietnamese People" called by some SDS (RYM-2), Newsreel, LNS and other groups. We will march with them if it turns out to be a broad coaltion and includes for example, other SDS factions and radical groups. Support for the Vietnamese People has grown too broad and too important to be in anyway restricted by our sectarianisms. More than ever before there will be open and vigorous support for the PRG's, just position on the end to the war — IMMEDIATE AND UNCONDITIONAL WITHDRAWAL OF ALL U.S. AND SATELLITE TROOPS FROM VIETNAM!

In addition to the many banners of the PRG (the same as the NLF) that will be carried by many different groups, we will be carrying banners of the Neo Lao Haksat. We urge individuals and groups to make and carry their own flags. The struggles are the same and deserve our support:

We will be distributing for free, as much material on Vietnam as we can get to Wash. D. C.. Most of the people who will be there are generally apolitical and know very little about what is really going on in Viet Nam and less about the only, just solution to the war in Viet Nam. Considering the obfuscation tactics of Nixon et al and the misleading co-optation of the Moratorium moderates and professional "Liberals," it is more important than ever that the content and meaning of the NLF and PRG's 10 point just solution to the Vietnam war be widely discussed understood and supported by all of the people in the peace movement. We want to publish an edit ed copy of the recent PRG newspaper "South Viet Nam in Struggle" which included full information of the formation membership, structure, program and aims of the PRG. This paper would include the 10 point Solution and would be distributed free to 20,000 people in Wash., D. C. on the 15th and 16th. To do this we need to raise \$300.00 by Monday or at least know that that amount well be forthcoming.
